

Typing in the Ge'ez Languages of Ethiopia & Eritrea

The Modern Ge'ez keyboard (U) is designed to make it easy to type all 523 letters, punctuation and numerals specified for “Ethiopic Script” in the Unicode standard. In addition, this keyboard package provides two additional fonts to help type 59 “alternative” letter shapes (Appendix A).

The languages of Ethiopian and Eritrea that use the Ge'ez script have many additions. The languages also use the same letters but sometimes with different sounds. A number of letters that were in use by a language for a short time were also abandoned. The keyboard package groups letters currently in use as the “Modern Ge'ez Syllabary”, and letters formerly in use as the “Legacy Ge'ez Syllabary” (Appendix B & C). The letters in use are given the higher priority and are a little easier to type and enter on touchscreen layouts.

Typing letters follows the spoken sounds and are matched to corresponding English letters (a style called “phonetic”). You can think of how a word sounds and then type it out with English.

Example: typing **selam** becomes ሳላም

Because Ethio-Eri languages have more sounds than English does, we sometimes have to adjust this rule. For example, English does not have ‘m’ and the closest similar letter would be ‘t’. In this case you should type with “capital T”:

Example: typing **TienaysTIN** becomes ተኞይስቲን

When the letter you want to type does not appear when you hit the similar sounding key in English, try using the capital next. If typing the capital does not work, then try hitting the key two times:

Example: typing **sselam** becomes ሂላም

Example: typing **SSeHey** becomes ይዘይ

Next, when you need to type the extra letters of Amharic and other languages like: አ፣ ዓ፣ ን you can do so by typing an extra vowel after a ‘u’:

Example: typing **mua** becomes መያ

Example: typing **guie** becomes ገዢ

Finally, we must introduce a special rule for ' (apostrophe). Some words are spelt with a እኩለ (6th) letter followed by a vowel, like **ርከ** in **የብርከል**. We use the apostrophe here to type “gebr'iel” to make sure we get “ርከ” instead of ‘ሩ’.

Example: typing **mel'ak** becomes መልክ

Example: typing **m'Eraf** becomes መደራፍ

If an apostrophe, ', is needed after a እኩለ letter in your document, type it twice like:

Example: k" to produce ከ'

The following typing tables show how to type all Modern and Legacy Ge'ez letters, numbers, and punctuation.

Modern Gurage Shapes

Modern Gurage uses some letter shapes that modify the traditional Ge'ez shapes used by other languages. Both can be typed, but priority is given to the Ge'ez shapes. In these cases when two shapes are available, the Gurage shape can be typed by adding an extra vowel as shown in the table below:

Consonant and Vowel Marks

Dots can be added above letters to indicate a stressed vowel or consonant using “**CTRL + .**”. For example:

አ ከ **CTRL .** ⇒ አጀ (“abaa”, “a” is stressed)
አጀ **CTRL .** ⇒ አጀ (“abba”, “b” is stressed)
አጀ **CTRL .** ⇒ አጀ (“abbaa”, “b” and “a” are stressed)

Period, ‘.’ may also be used to enter ‘፳’. When a number follows ‘፡’, ‘፣’ and ‘፳’ they will change back to their Latin form automatically. For example:

123፡456 ⇒ 123,456 , 12፳ 50 ⇒ 12.50 , 12፡50 ⇒ 12:50

Keyboard Punctuation

All regular punctuation on your keyboard remains available. Most punctuation can be typed with a single keystroke as usual. Those used to input Ethiopic symbols can be entered by hitting the punctuation key two or more times until it appears.

Typing Numbers

The hash mark is used Ge’ez numbers, so #1 becomes ዲ and so on. When a ‘#’ is needed before a number in your document, just type # twice.

Type the number that corresponds to the qirts that you want and it will appear and the menu close.

Appendix A: Alternative Letter Shapes

The shapes of letters may change over the centuries, and by region, language, or individual, etc. The Abyssinica SIL font provides the most commonly found variant shapes. The alternative shapes are typed as you would the regular shapes, however an “alternate” font must be selected. The fonts “Abyssinica SIL Alternate 1” and “Abyssinica SIL Alternate 2” are installed with this keyboard package and may be selected as shown in the following tables to reveal the alternative letter shapes.
